

Announcement of Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna

on Expression of Good Faith Intention, Moral Policies, and Administrative Transparency

According to the fact that the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand (Interim) B.E. 2557 (2014), the Official Information Act B.E. 2540 (1997), the Royal Decree on Criteria and Procedures for Good Governance B.E. 2546 (2003), the National Anti-Corruption Strategy Phase 2 (2013 – 2017) and Phase 3 (2017 – 2021), and the government policy No.10 regarding the promotion of public administration with good governance and prevention and suppression of corruption and misconducts in governmental sector, intend to indoctrinate the values of morality, ethics, and conscience of protecting the dignity of being a governmental officer and of honesty and to encourage effective public administration in order to prevent and suppress corruption and misconducts committed by all levels of public officials, to fulfill the needs and provide convenience to people, and to build trust in civil services,

Associate Professor Prapat Chueathai, Acting President of Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna, hereby declares good faith intention and sets out policies on morality and transparency as standards, guidelines, and values, for governmental officers and personnel of the organization to bear in mind and implement them along with other rules and regulations. This aims to lead the organization to transparent performance and honest and moral administration and without corruption in the following manners:

1. Administration and performance of work must be in accordant with good governance principle and aim to fulfill the needs of people with fast, accurate, equal, transparent, and fair services;

2. Values and attitudes on acquiring knowledge, holding on to morality and ethics, and applying the philosophical principle of sufficiency economy to work and to livelihood must be indoctrinated;

3. Every step of procurement must be carried out in a transparent manner and private sector, social sector, and public sector must be able to participate in investigating any actions by disclosing information of all kinds of activities;

4. Advise to people encouraging them to inform information regarding activities that are carried out according to the tasks of the University that is beneficial to community, society, and the nation;

5. If corruption is found, the corrupted person will be seriously investigated and punished to the highest degree.
