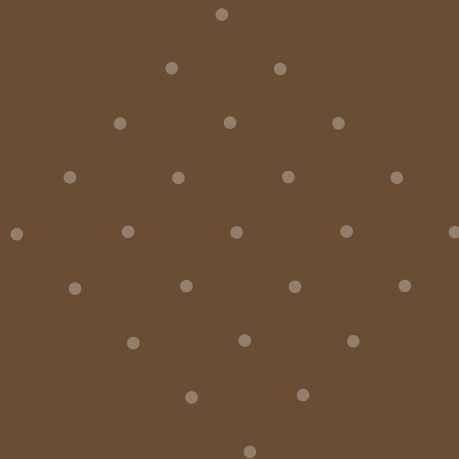

RMUTL BACKGROUND

Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna has been offering vocational education programs in industrial technician, business administration, architecture, fine arts, and agriculture in the northern region for over 50 years, with continuous development since February 27, 1975.

Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna, Chiang Mai (Head Campus), is located at 128 Huay Kaew Road, Chang Phueak Subdistrict, Mueang District, Chiang Mai Province and was established on August 8, 1957, under the name of Payap Technical College. In 1975, the college was promoted to a University of Technology and Vocational Education, Payap Technical Campus, which later changed its name to Rajamangala Institute of Technology, Payap Campus and then to Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna, Payap Region, Chiang Mai.

Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna, Chiang Mai, has outstanding potential in educational management in science, technology, engineering, fine arts, architecture, business administration, and liberal arts. The university also preserves the inheritance of arts, culture, and folk wisdom to produce graduates and create works that are well-known in the community, society, and the world.





GET TO KNOW RMUTL

Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna is located in the Wiang Chet Lin area, an ancient town or Chet Buri, at 128 Huay Kaew Road, Chang Phueak Subdistrict, Mueang District, Chiang Mai Province.

The university was formerly known as "Payap Technical College," which was a vocational education institution under the Department of Vocational Education, Ministry of Education, founded on August 8, 1957.

On February 27, 1975, Payap Technical College became affiliated with the College of Technology and Vocational Education under the name "College of Technology and Vocational Education Payap Technical Campus." The objective was to produce vocational education teachers at the undergraduate level, provide vocational education at a bachelor's degree level, and provide academic services to society to develop quality teaching systems and potential in many areas.

On September 15, 1988, His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej granted a new name to the College of Technology and Vocational Education, which became the "Rajamangala Institute of Technology" which means the auspicious institution of the King. The objective is to develop and organize education in accordance with the national policy and the labor market's need for graduates to practice science and technology.

The university has five faculties, including the Faculty of Business Administration and Liberal Arts, the Faculty of Agricultural Science and Technology, the Faculty of Engineering, the Faculty of Fine Arts and Architecture, and the College of Integrated Science and Technology.

RMUTL LOGO

The Rajamangala symbol takes the form of a circle, with the Phra Maha Phichai Crown underneath.

Inside the circle is an 8-petal lotus flower, symbolizing wisdom and the light in the world. Within the lotus blossom is a royal image, which serves as the seal of His Majesty the King, who bestowed the name "Rajamangala University of Technology". A pair of nectar flowers are located at the end of the bar, representing prosperity, brightness, and joy.

The fineness of The "Rajamangala" symbol is known and appreciated by the people of Rajamangala and the general public. Rajamangala University of Technology is an institution that is committed to its mission of strengthening professional education, fostering progress, and expanding its branches, as it continues to honor the generosity of His Majesty the King.



RMUTL COLOR

Golden brown symbolizes lasting prosperity, which is comparable to Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna located in a region that thrives in education, arts, and culture, serving as a base for promoting graduates with moral principles and advancing the university as a center of continuous learning.

Golden brown is a neutral color created by combining features that can be integrated with all colors, making it stand out beautifully. Similarly, Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna is committed to integrated management within the region to produce graduates who are well-prepared in all aspects, contributing to social development, and leading a happy, self-reliant life.





RMUTL TREE

Kasalong, also known as *Millingtonia hortensis*, is a tree widely recognized in Lanna for its white flowers, which symbolize purity and virtue, and its fragrant blooms, reminiscent of the reputation and prestige of the university.

"According to Thai culture, Kasalong is considered a sacred tree that, when grown, brings honor and fame to the surrounding area." Kasalong has strong, airy stems. There are white flower bouquets blooming downward, similar to the characteristics of the university's graduates who possess moral integrity, ethics, expertise, and knowledge to foster sustainable development and prosperity for society and the nation."

• Summary of Key Requirements for • Registration for Undergraduate Students with a High Vocational Diploma (High Vocational Certificate)

- Students must register and pay tuition fees in each semester within the time specified by the university to complete the courses.
- Course registration must be approved by a student advisor and in accordance with the course requirements.
- For the first or second semester, students must register for a minimum of 9 credits and a maximum of:
 - a. 22 credits for a bachelor's degree
 - b. 24 credits for a High Vocational Diploma (High Vocational Certificate)
- For the summer semester, students may register for a maximum of 9 credits.
- Registration for credits outside the limits in items 3 and 4 must be approved by the academic advisor and the Dean on a case-by-case basis.
- Late payment of tuition fees will incur a fine of 50 baht per day after the deadline specified by the university.
- Overdue payment of tuition fees will result in withdrawal from the university.
- Students who do not wish to register for the first or second semester must request to maintain their student status within 30 days of the start of the semester. If the deadline is missed, the student's name will be withdrawn.
*Students do not need to register to maintain their status during the summer semester.
- Students wishing to register for the summer semester must pay the registration fee within the specified period. Late payment will result in the voiding of the registration.
- Students must pass a prerequisite exam for courses with prerequisite courses. Failure to do so will result in the voiding of registration for that subject.

● WITHDRAWAL OF ● REGISTERED COURSES

01

Courses that are withdrawn will not appear on transcripts in the following cases:

Course withdrawal within 14 days from the start of the first or second semester


Course withdrawal within 7 days from the start of the summer semester

02

Courses that are withdrawn will appear with a "T" or "W" on the transcript. In case of course withdrawal after the schedule specified in item 11, but not exceeding the following schedule:

12 weeks for the first or second semester

5 weeks for the summer semester



• Transfer • of Grades

- 01 Students must submit a request for transfer of academic results within 30 days of the start of the first semester.
- 02 Students must specify the courses they want to transfer along with their grades and submit it to their advisor within the specified period.
- 03 Courses that can be transferred must have a grade of not lower than "C" or "C+".
- 04 The number of credits that can be transferred must not exceed 75% of the total credits of the courses admitted.
- 05 Courses approved for transfer will be recorded as a "TC" on the transcript.
- 06 Courses approved for transfer will not be considered for the cumulative grade point average.
- 07 The courses eligible for transfer are subject to announcements by the Faculty.

- 01** Multiply the number of credits per course (listed in box 6) by the grade received for that course to obtain the course product.
- 02** Add up the course products for all courses taken during the semester (excluding any courses that have been withdrawn). The sum is referred to as the Division Total.
- 03** Total the number of credits for all courses taken during the semester (excluding any courses that have been withdrawn). The sum is referred to as the Total Semester Credits.
- 04** Calculate the semester average using the following equation:

$$\text{SEMESTER AVERAGE} = \frac{\text{DIVISION TOTAL}}{\text{TOTAL SEMESTER CREDITS}}$$

ROUND THE RESULT TO TWO DECIMAL PLACES,
ROUNDING DOWN FOR THE THIRD DECIMAL PLACE.

● CALCULATING CUMULATIVE ● GRADE POINT AVERAGE

- 01** Multiply the number of credits per course (listed in box 6) by the grade received for that course to obtain the course product.
- 02** Add up the course products for all courses taken since the first semester (excluding any courses that have been withdrawn). The sum is referred to as the Accumulative Total Multiplication.
- 03** Total the number of credits for all courses taken since the first semester (excluding any courses that have been withdrawn). The sum is referred to as the Cumulative Total Credits.
- 04** Calculate the semester average using the following equation:

$$\begin{array}{l} \text{CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE} = \\ \frac{\text{ACCUMULATIVE TOTAL MULTIPLICATION}}{\text{CUMULATIVE TOTAL CREDITS}} \\ \text{ROUND THE RESULT TO TWO DECIMAL PLACES,} \\ \text{ROUNDING DOWN FOR THE THIRD DECIMAL PLACE.} \end{array}$$

• Calculation of Cumulative Grade • Point Average in case of

- 01** Re-registering to improve a grade of O or F:
Only the credits and grades from the most recent registration should be counted, and the credits from previous semesters should not be included in the calculation.
- 02** Registering for classes to improve grades of D, D+, or D+. Re-grading:
 - A** Only the credits and grades from the most recent registration should be counted.
 - B** Subtract the credits and grades earned in the previous semester before calculating the cumulative grade point average for the semester in which the courses are taken to improve the grades.
 - C** There is no need to revise the semester grade point average or cumulative grade point average from previous semesters.
 - D** An example of calculating the cumulative grade point average for courses taken to improve grades can be found in the "Guidelines for Undergraduate Education Management" B.E. 2557 at Rajamangala University of Technology Lanna.

Criteria for Termination of Student Status

- 01 Spending more than twice the duration of the course of study from the date of registration as a student.
- 02 Failure to meet the evaluation criteria:

Master's Degree:

A semester grade point average of less than 2.50 at the end of the first semester or a cumulative grade point average of less than 2.50 will result in termination of student status.

Request for Graduation

Students who wish to graduate must meet the following qualifications and requirements:

- 01** Pass all courses and earn the required number of credits as specified in the course curriculum.
- 02** Achieve a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.00 upon completion of their final exams.
- 03** Submit a graduation request form during the expected semester of graduation, within 60 days from the start of the first or second semester, and within 35 days from the start of the summer semester.
- 04** Note that there is no obligation for the university to approve the graduation request.
- 05** If students are unable to complete their studies in the semester for which they submitted their graduation request, they must submit a new request for every subsequent semester in which they expect to complete their studies.

Obtaining an Honors Degree

for Undergraduate Students

01 Register for courses at the university, earning:

- a. 72 credits for transfer courses
- b. 120 credits for a 4-year program
- c. 150 credits for a 5-year program

02 Graduate within the course of study without taking a leave of absence.

03 Ensure that they have not received grades T, D, D+, or MCU/F, D, D+, or U in any course.

04 Students with a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher will be nominated for a First Class Honors degree.

05 Students with a cumulative GPA of 3.50 to 3.74 will be nominated for a 2nd Class Honors degree.

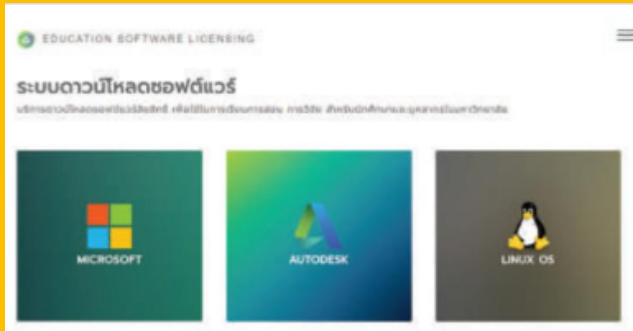

(VPN Network)

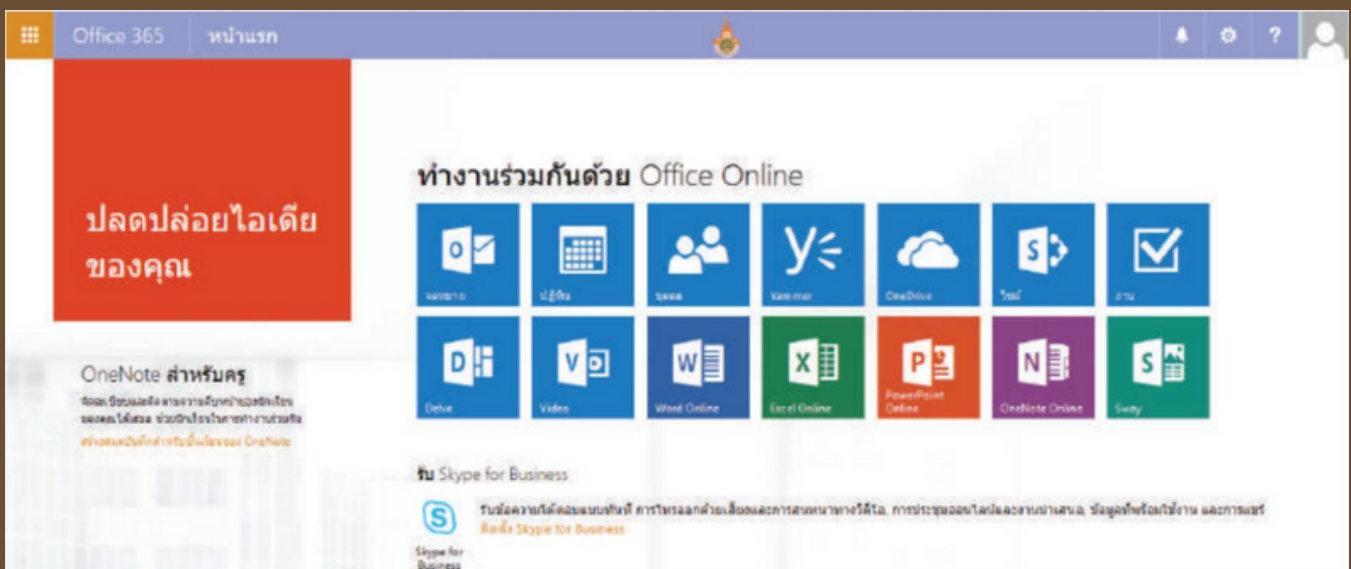

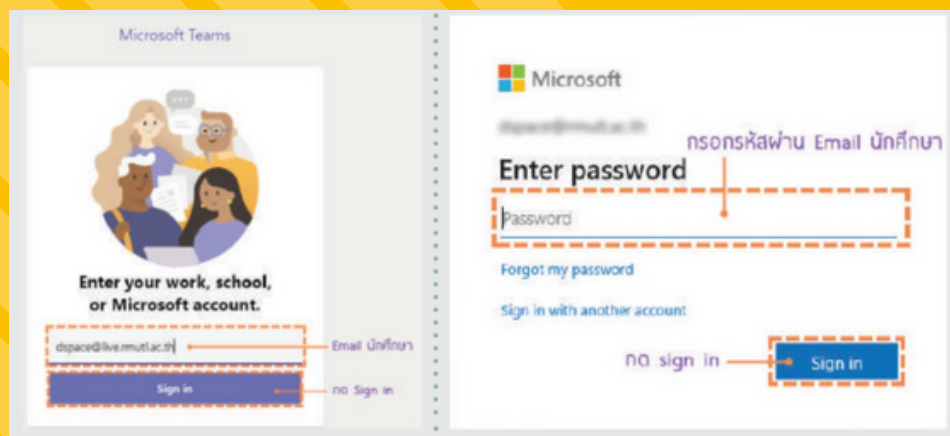


To access online classes with Microsoft Teams, students must:

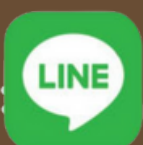
ACCESSING ONLINE CLASSES

UNIFORM of RMUTL STUDENT

Male students

Shirt

Male students are required to wear a white shirt with short sleeves at elbow length or long sleeves at wrist length with five front buttons. The shirt must have a small pocket at the left chest level. The hem of the shirt must be tucked neatly inside the trousers.

Trousers

Male students are required to wear trousers with a polite and universal style. The trousers must be in navy blue or black color with no patterns. The male students must not roll up the trousers.

Belt

Male students are required to wear a black color belt.

Buckle

Male students are required to wear a silver buckle displaying the university logo with a size of 4.5 x 4.5 centimeters.

Shoes

Male students are required to wear polite black leather shoes without patterns.

Pin

Male students are required to attach a pin displaying a university logo with a size of 1.5 centimeters.

Socks

Male students are required to wear black socks without any patterns.

Female students

Shirt

Female students are required to wear a white shirt with short sleeves at elbow length with silver buttons displaying a university logo with a size of 1.8 centimeters.

Skirts

Female students are required to wear straight high-waisted skirts with a placket at the back. The skirts must be in navy blue or black with no patterns.

Belt

Female students are required to wear a black color belt

Buckle

Female students are required to wear a silver buckle displaying the university logo with a size of 4.5 x 4.5 centimeters.

Pin

Female students are required to attach a pin displaying a university logo with a size of 1.5 centimeters.

Shoes

Female students are required to wear polite black shoes without patterns.
