



Once an applicant is admitted, UINSA acts as the applicant's facilitator or sponsor during the applicant's study period in Indonesia.


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The university will then submit an application to the Indonesian Ministry of Religious Affairs for the applicant's study permit.

Following the issuance of the study permit, the university will assist you in obtaining a limited stay visa (VITAS) from the nearest Indonesian Embassy/Consulate in your country.

Please keep in mind that obtaining a study permit and visa will take at least three/four months. UINSA's International office will gladly assist you with the above requirements.

Welcome to the City of Heroes!

Surabava, Indonesia's second largest city and one of the most renowned historical cities, offers a pleasant mix of historical and modern sites to visit. Historically, Surabaya was a city where the people fought an uphill battle against the Dutch and allied forces during World War II, culminating in the people of Surabaya's victory over the allied forces. This incident becomes one of Indonesia's national holidays, called 'Hari Pahlawan' (the Day of Heroes), and Surabaya is named "Kota Pahlawan (City of Heroes).
